## MV Agusta Monoalbero (1957)

A true collector's gem: the 1957 MV Agusta Monoalbero is a rare factory racer with a single overhead camshaft and unmistakable pedigree. This purpose-built machine represents MV Agusta's racing legacy during the golden era of lightweight Grand Prix motorcycles.

It features a 175 cc single-cylinder engine (monoalbero), developed in-house by MV Agusta's Corse department. The design is unmistakably Italian: red, minimal, and made for speed. With race-focused details like a dry clutch, close-ratio gearbox, and magnesium covers, this bike was engineered for the podium.

This particular example is unrestored and without registration—exactly as a true track-only racer should be. An exceptional opportunity for connoisseurs of pure, original competition machinery
